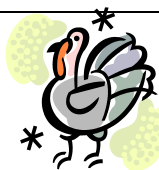

Starting ballet as a young child has both physical and mental advantages. Young minds are adept at learning new languages, and ballet is definitely a language. Young bodies are ideal for cultivating long lines and strong technique.

...**Late Bloomers.** Children who begin ballet at a later age just need the patience to let their bodies re-shape.

...**Point shoes.** Each dancer's age & technique is evaluated for the correct time to begin pointe shoes.

...**Stay with it.** A child at any age can change drastically in 12 months.
